Shop abroad without a passport at these global sites



Can't jet off to someplace exotic this summer? Now you can rummage through African artifacts or shop at trendy Tokyo boutiques without jet lag, long lines or luggage. All you need are the following URLs. But before you point and click, stop by [xe.com](#) for a currency converter (so you'll know what you'll be paying in dollars, not drachmas) and consult [onlineconversion.com](#) for sizing charts. And review each site's shipping costs and return policy before hitting Buy.

Fake a trip to the Riviera at [cantoracapri.com](#). For more than 50 years this Capri boutique has catered to the jet set with its renowned hand-made jeweled sandals (\$163 to \$254). Then head to Spain for flat or wedge-heel espadrilles (\$22.50 to \$132) at [espadrillesetc.com](#), a site also stocked

with colorful straw baskets (\$42 to \$66) for the beach or a picnic. Fill your home with the scent of Provence at [essencedeprovence.com](#), which offers all things lavender, from wreaths (\$22.50 to \$75) to soaps (\$13 for a box of two). Anglophiles can order a fitted shirt from British tailor

Step out in Capri style at [cantoracapri.com](#) (left). A colored-glass Moorish chandelier (right, \$245) is from [justmorocco.com](#).

Charles Tyrwhitt (\$85 to \$120) at [ctshirts.com](#) or splurge on a sleek hobo bag (\$817) from New Bond Street's high-end leather goods shop [mulberry.com](#).

middle east

The lure of Marrakech bazaars beckons at [justmorocco.com](#) with bright hand-painted platters (\$35) and embroidered cushions. Buy Turkish trinkets like a gold evil-eye bracelet (\$148) at [eyezoneyou.com](#), or comb through artifacts by region and historical period

at [ancientart.co.uk](#), where authentic ancient Egyptian beads are restrung into jewelry (earrings, a multi-strand necklace and a bracelet, \$145 for a set). For more contemporary accessories, like 14kt-gold earrings with blue opals (left), go

bold array of patterns and finished styles (\$57 and \$67, low), sift through the select at [grahmkandiah.com](#). Elate Chinese teapots (\$60.50), simple bamboo pots (\$36.50), classic finds on [yixing.com](#), while [onotoko.com](#) provides a trend take on the East with its up-the-minute threads from streets of Tokyo.
